ANNUAL TRAVELCARD

(all zones)

With an annual travelcard (all zones), you can bring a companion with you free of charge from Monday to Friday from 7 p.m. and all day on weekends (Saturday/Sunday, public holidays).

In addition, you benefit from discounts with partners in Zug and the surrounding area throughout the year: for example, a 30% discount on a day ticket for the Rigi Bahnen or a 20% discount in the EVZ fan shop. You can find further offers at tvzg.ch/gutscheine. The offer is valid for one year from the date of purchase.

Requirements for receiving digital vouchers

Please enter your e-mail address in your SwissPass account at www.swisspass.ch or at a public transport sales point. If you do not provide an e-mail address, you will not be entitled to the vouchers.

Good to know

Validity

The zone ticket entitles the holder to make any number of journeys within the purchased zones and the specified time on all public transport in the Zug fare network (bus, train, mountain railway).

The boats on Lake Zug and Lake Ägeri are not included in the fare network. Network tickets are valid until the last or from the first scheduled stop within the purchased area of validity.

Connecting tickets

Within the Zug fare network, you can purchase connecting tickets as a supplement to your monthly or annual pass.

The prices are identical to those of single tickets/day tickets.

If you have paid for a total of 5 zones for your season ticket and connecting ticket, you are entitled to travel freely throughout the entire Zug fare network during the period of validity of the connecting ticket.

Module travelcard

If you regularly commute between fare networks or outside a fare network and would like to use local transport, the Module Pass is the ideal solution. Further information is available at www.sbb.ch/modul-abo.

SwissPass

All subscriptions are referenced on the SwissPass. To obtain your first SwissPass card free of charge, you will need a passport photo (physical/electronic) and official identification. If you lose your card, you can obtain a replacement for CHF 30.

Ticket inspections

Tickets must be retained until the end of the journey and presented to inspection staff upon request. Please validate your e-ticket before boarding. Persons without a valid ticket will be charged a surcharge of CHF 100, which will increase in the event of repeat offences. If you have forgotten your season ticket, you will only be charged CHF 5 instead of CHF 100 upon presentation of your season ticket.

Travelling with animals

Dogs are eligible for a 'Reduced 1/2' ticket (2nd class). Small dogs, cats and similar tame small animals up to 30 cm in height travel free of charge in appropriate containers. The dog pass (GA validity area) is referenced on the personal SwissPass of the accompanying person. It is therefore not transferable to other accompanying persons. Valid for any dog.

Transporting bicycles

A bicycle ticket must be purchased for bicycles; this is a 'Reduced 1/2' ticket (2nd class). Please note: The Zugerberg Trail offer includes transport of your bicycle on the ZBB, as well as use of the trail and the washing area. An additional ticket must be purchased for your bicycle for the journey to the Zugerberg Railway. Self-loading of bicycles is only permitted on lines 601, 602 and 612 at certain stops:

Line 601: Zug, Bahnhofplatz / Unterägeri, Zentrum / Oberägeri, Station

Line 602: Zug, Bahnhofplatz / Menzingen, Dorf / Menzingen, Kreuzegg

Line 612: Zug, Bahnhofplatz / Allenwinden, Dorf / Unterägeri, Zentrum / Oberägeri, Station

If there is insufficient space, the driver will decide whether to allow the bicycle on board. The transport companies in the Zug fare network accept no liability for damage to bicycles during transport.
